Voters' Meeting: The regular monthly voters' meeting will be held on **Tuesday, September 7** at 7pm in the school cafeteria. In addition to officer reports and membership changes the following items are on the agenda.

- Proposed changes to the constitution and by-laws of Zion Lutheran will be discussed at this meeting, however a vote on the changes will not be taken until the October meeting.
- A resolution concerning worship times. It is the recommendation of the Board of Elders that the weekend worship schedule (Saturday at 7pm and Sunday at 9am) remain unchanged and that an informal evening service be added on Wednesdays at 7pm, beginning in October.

Two resolutions concerning hiring an admissions counselor for the school

- Zion Lutheran Board of Christian Day School moves to accept the job description for the Admissions Counselor to assist with promoting the school. Funds for the position based on the job description will be furnished entirely by the Board of Christian Day School.
- Zion Lutheran Board of Christian Day School moves the Board of Christian Day School be authorized to hire the school's Admission Counselor for a 6 month period. The timeline includes: (1) Advertise job opening to the congregation in October 2010 (2) Interview and hire in November 2010 (3) Training in December 2010 (4) Begin position in January 2011. Evaluation will occur in June of 2011 at which time a recommendation will be made concerning the future of the position.

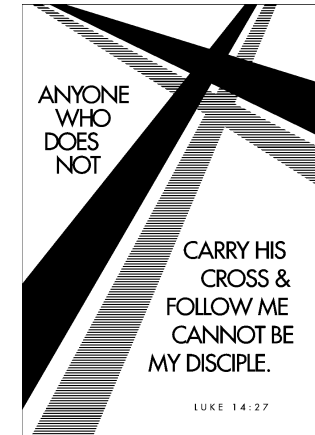
