Lesson 37: Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth! Serve the Lord with gladness! Come into His presence with singing! *Psalm 100:1-2*

Lesson 71: As many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. ... you are all one in Christ Jesus.
Galatians 3:27-28

Lesson 72: He saved us... by washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by His grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life. The saying is trustworthy. *Titus 3:5-8*

Lesson 73: Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? We were buried therefore with Him by Baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. *Romans 6:3-4*

Lesson 74: For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.

Lesson 75: Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good! *Psalm 34:8*

Lesson 76: The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.

Lesson 40: For our sake He made Him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God. *2 Corinthians 5:21*

Lesson 41: Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days He has spoken to us by His Son, whom He appointed the heir of all things, through whom also He created the world. *Hebrews 1:1-2*

Lesson 42: In Christ God was reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation.
2 Corinthians 5:19

Lesson 43: I have blotted out your transgressions like a cloud and your sins like mist; return to Me, for I have redeemed you. *Isaiah 44:22*

Lesson 44: Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. *Hebrews 11:1*

Lesson 45: Jesus says: "Surely I am coming soon." We reply "Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!" *Revelation 22:20*

Lesson 46: Therefore God has highly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord. *Philippians 2:9-11*

Lesson 47: By this all people will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another. *John 13:35*

Lesson 48: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; and the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks it will be opened.
Matthew 7:7-8

Lesson 49: So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in Him, “If you abide in My word, you are truly My disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.” *John 8:31-32*

Lesson 50: Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from Your presence, and take not Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit. *Psalms 51:10-12*

Lesson 51: Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ. *Colossians 3:23-24*

Lesson 52: Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer. *Psalms 19:14*

Lesson 53: I will be a father to you, and you shall be sons and daughters to Me, says the Lord Almighty.
2 Corinthians 6:18

Lesson 54: For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in Him should have eternal life. *John 6:40*

Lesson 55: Oh give thanks to the Lord, for He is good, for His steadfast love endures forever! Let the redeemed of the Lord say so. *Psalms 107:1-2*

Lesson 56: The Lord will keep you from all evil; He will keep your life. The Lord will keep your going out and your coming in from this time forth and forevermore.

Lesson 57: Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. *1 Thessalonians 5:16-18*

Lesson 58: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sin and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. *1 John 1:8-9*

Lesson 59: Who can discern his errors? Declare me innocent from hidden faults. *Psalms 19:12*

Lesson 60: Repent therefore, and turn again, that your sins may be blotted out, that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord. *Acts 3:19-20*

Lesson 61: Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you.
